

# Central Reopening Guidelines



## SUNDAY SERVICE INFORMATION:

1. Both the 9:00am and 11:15am services will be identical.
2. The first service will be at 9:00am, and the second at 11:15am. We ask that if you choose to worship in person with us, you attend the service time that coordinates with your shepherding group/last name. These groups are as follows:

### 9:00 am. Group A

Barry Tucker/ Blakely — Cross  
Steven Stewart/ Crowson — Holley

### 11:15am. Group B

Frank Noblitt/ Hornberger — Morgan  
Len Nicholson/ Morrow — Smith

(Group "A" and Group "B" will alternate between the two meeting times from week to week.)

3. Families should sit together. Families will be ushered into the auditorium from front to the back and seated on the ends of the pews. No one will sit in the middle.
4. We will be limiting entrance to the building to the front doors only.
5. Doors will be propped open if possible and opened for you by gloved greeters.
6. We will not pass the offering plate. Buckets will be located in the foyer where you can give. (You can always give online @ [tithe.ly](https://tithe.ly))
7. You are welcome to wear a mask, gloves or any other measures you deem necessary. This is a judgement free zone. We will NOT be passing communion/offering plates. Communion will be prepackaged. You will be given one by a gloved usher as you enter the auditorium.
8. Please do not gather in the foyer.
9. Coffee and drinking fountains will not be available. You may bring your own drink as long as it has a lid.
10. Upon the conclusion of service, ushers will escort people out starting with the back and finishing with the front of the auditorium. This will prevent people from congregating in the narrow aisles.
11. The nursery will be unmanned but will be available for children who need it.
12. We encourage you to refrain from handshakes and hugs, show your love and be creative.

## **OUR CLEANING PROCEDURES:**

Our cleaning volunteers have taken extra steps to clean our campus, and will continue to do so.

- \* Carpets cleaned
- \* Floors waxed
- \* Pews and chairs in auditorium & foyer sanitized
- \* Door handles sanitized
- \* Kids area deep-cleaned
- \* Bathrooms sanitized
- \* All surfaces that have been used will be cleaned after both services
- \* Hand sanitizer will be available, but please bring your own if you can. Our supply is limited due to back-order from our supplier. We will gladly accept donations of sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, Lysol, etc.
- We will be sanitizing restrooms and chairs after every service. This may take some time. To help us, please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before the service begins. You will be asked to leave shortly after the service concludes.

## **WHO SHOULD NOT ATTEND CHURCH DURING THIS TIME**

- Older adults and people of any age with underlying health conditions, such as diabetes, lung disease, or heart disease, who are at greater risk of severe illness from COVID-19. Please stay home and watch online.

- If anyone is uncomfortable worshipping with us on campus, there is no pressure. Come back when you feel comfortable.
